MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Three (3) years experience in small engine maintenance and repair to include: Briggs & Stratton, Kohler, Kawasaki, and Honda experience.
- Valid driver license. Must obtain Florida driver license within thirty (30) days of employment.
 - Driving history for the past three (3) years must reflect no violations of a driving related offense, <u>or</u> driving under the influence (DUI) which includes both drugs and alcohol, reckless driving, or hit and run involving an occupied vehicle or attended property, <u>or</u> an accumulation of traffic violations, plus three (3) points for each attendance at driving school (regardless of whether points were assessed against the license) where the penalty points do not exceed twelve (12).

PREFERABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

- Three (3) years experience in diesel engine repair.
- GEM (Global Electric Motorcars) electrical cart experience.

POSITION FUNCTION:

Perform scheduled maintenance and repairs to small engine equipment, lawn equipment and fractional horsepower engines.

Tasks/Duties of Small Engine Technician

Below is a summary of the Tasks and Duties of this position. For a listing of duties and responsibilities for this position, please see the Job Specification/Demands Analysis included with the posting in the City Hall lobby.

TASK/DUTY

Perform scheduled maintenance on small engine equipment, to include ride-on and walk-behind mowers, fractional horsepower engines, compressors, generators, pumps and sprayers.

Perform scheduled maintenance on small diesel engines, to include water pumps, wood chippers, tractors and compact utility vehicles.

Complete necessary repairs to small engine equipment, to include fractional engine overhauls, carburetors, tune ups, hydraulic and drive systems, transmissions, and all other worn or damaged components.

Remove, replace and sharpen lawn equipment blades.

Diagnose and repair faulty electrical system components to include starting and charging systems, electronic engine controls, lighting, accessories and wiring harnesses, etc.

Properly complete work orders and maintain an accurate work history on all equipment.

Drive to and from various locations and perform service calls to equipment in the field.

Communicate effectively with parts personnel to acquire both inventoried and special order parts.
