#### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Six (6) months experience finishing concrete, block, and brickwork, or one (1) year experience in a construction trade.
- Valid driver license. (Must obtain Florida Driver License within thirty (30) days of employment)

Driving history for the past three (3) years must reflect no violations of a driving related offense, <u>or</u> driving under the influence (DUI) which includes both drugs and alcohol, reckless driving, or hit and run involving an occupied vehicle or attended property, <u>or</u> an accumulation of traffic violations, plus three (3) points for each attendance at driving school (regardless of whether points were assessed against the license) where the penalty points do not exceed twelve (12).

- Experience in the installation of storm drainage pipes.
- General carpentry skills.
- Class C Stormwater license.

  - o Basic ICS-100 (6 months)

Supply skilled labor in concrete construction and maintenance of the City's stormwater system.

## **Tasks/Duties of Construction Specialist**

Below is a summary of the Tasks and Duties of this position. For a listing of duties and responsibilities for this position, please see the Job Specification/Demands Analysis included with the posting in the City Hall lobby.

#### TASK/DUTY

Perform all concrete type work: foundations, spillways, retaining walls, rip rap dams, walls, sidewalks, inlets and outfalls, and assist in all concrete maintenance duties.

Block and brick laying, carpentry work and making forms.

Removal of sod, digging and setting forms; mixing, pouring and finishing concrete, installation of drainage pipes and maintenance of City retention ponds, including mowing.

Drive dump truck (Under 26,000 lbs.) and operate light/heavy equipment: concrete mixer, concrete saws, compressors, generators, pumps, mowers; and able to use small hand tools and concrete finishing tools.

Assist Streets and Sanitation in spring and fall clean-up and Christmas tree recycling, and emergency situations.

Able to work from a boat and assist in the operation and maintenance of stormwater pumps.

Must be available for emergency callouts and on call duty.

Perform additional duties, as assigned.

To communicate effectively, verbally and in writing, and follow oral & written instructions.

\* Drive Lightning Loader and Dumptruck (26,000 lbs. or more) as needed.
